#### ***Centre for Adult Education - VCE***

Adults & Early School Leavers

The Centre for Adult Education (CAE) delivers a range of education programs for adults and young people looking to develop their skills for study or work. Located on Flinders Lane they are conveniently located near Flinders St Station and lots of tram lines.

#### ***Reconnect***

The Centre for Adult Education (CAE) provide a range of alternative and flexible education programs for young people including New Pathways Re Connect which is a tailored program for disadvantaged young people and provides mentoring, challenge activities, accredited training and personal support to assist early school leavers re-engage in education – students complete GCE and pathway into other programs.

#### ***VCAL***

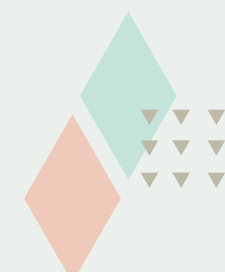
#### ***iVCAL***

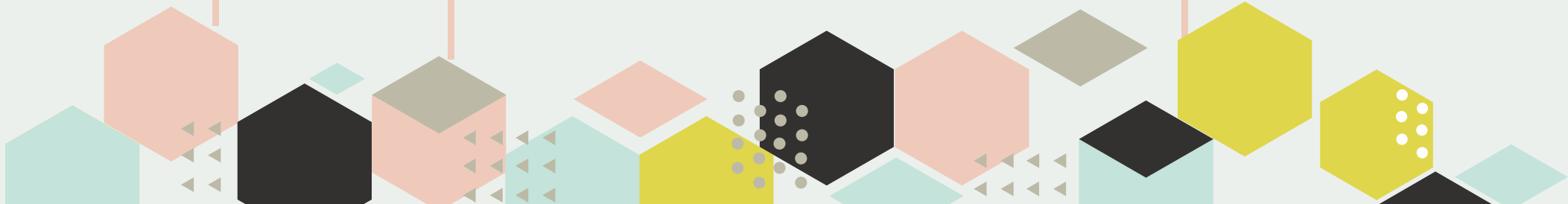

<p><b>Kensington Community High School</b></p>	<p>Youth in years 7- 12</p>	<p>Kensington Community High School provides practical learning initiatives in a safe, supportive educational environment, focusing on improving the futures of their students. With small class sizes, the school is a great alternative to mainstream schools allowing all young people to flourish in non-traditional approaches to education and allows students to complete a range of vocational and VET in Schools initiatives within their VCAL qualification. <p><b>STREAT</b></p>	<p>Youth aged 15 to 25</p>	<p>STREAT was started in 2009 in the City of Melbourne aiming to raise awareness and assist people experiencing homelessness. When STREAT kick-started, it offered a six-month Certificate II program to its young people. This has now evolved into a suite of programs including hospitality short courses, a Certificate II program, work experience opportunities and a creative arts program. <p><b>Hester Hornbrook Academy (Melbourne) via Front yard- Melbourne City Mission</b></p>	<p>Youth aged 15–25 years</p>	<p>The Hester Hornbrook Academy is an Independent school run by Melbourne City Mission. With the support of an Educator and a Youth Worker in every classroom, the Hester Hornbrook Academy aims to reconnect disengaged young people through a combination of learning and wellbeing support, through a curriculum which is flexible and tailored to each individual's interests and goals. The practical education programs are project-based and connected to real world employment skills. <p><b>William Angliss Institute (VCAL)</b></p>	<p>Students in years 11-12</p>	<p>At the William Angliss Institute as a VCAL student you will complete your course on campus, with small class sizes to ensure mentorship and close relationships with your peers. You will be responsible for driving your own learning to be best prepared for the working environment post-study. The four compulsory VCAL strands are literacy and numeracy skills; work related skills; industry specific skills and personal development skills.
